Delegates meeting 2024 (pt. 7-b.II)

Extension to clay target rule no. 5.12.s.

So far, this issue had not been mentioned. During the EC 2023 it has been discussed with the former chairwoman of the shotgun committee, Mrs. Jane Capewell, and she is also of the opinion to extend the rules by the following point (see new point in yellow):

- s.) A clay target will be deemed a 'No bird' and another clay will be granted to the competitor, whether he or she fired or not, only if:
- i) the clay breaks on launching;
- ii) the flight is not straight, is irregular or is too slow;
- iii) two or more clays are launched together;
- iv) the clay is of a different colour to that of preceding clays;
- v) the clay is launched before the order 'Pull'
- vi) the shooter has fired after the order "Pull" and no clay has been launched.
- vii) the clay is not launched immediately on the order 'Pull', providing the competitor indicates an intention not to shoot by raising the firearm;
- viii) the shooter fired from the wrong stand (up to a max. of 3 clays in a 25-clays relay, afterwards clays are lost) (see also art. 5.8.0)
- ix) a misfire or default is due to the mechanical breakdown of the firearm, the lock or the cock
