Cleaning of revolver cylinders during competitions

As, during the EC 2023, a shooter has been seen who has cleaned one chamber of the cylinder of his revolver whilst the other chambers were still loaded, there is the necessity to extend our rules as described below.

Proposal of Bernard Collot.

cleaning revolvers between shots. should be permitted only with an empty cylinder. rule says

"cleaning permitted" to be replaced by

Rule extension could read:

"cleaning of cylinder and/or barrel is only permitted when revolver is not loaded"

This applies for Mariette, Colt and Malson events

Proposal from Nick Harvey to Appendix C:

Cleaning of Revolvers: For clarity, I propose this rule specifies that chambers must be uncapped since, as written, it is open to interpretation since a pistol may be considered unloaded if the loaded cylinder is removed from the gun. The suggestion is to amend the proposed rule to state

'cleaning of cylinder and/or barrel is only permitted when revolver is not loaded or capped'.
