Delegates meeting 2024 (pt. 7-b.VI)

Differentiation between O and R

On suggestion of Mrs. Gerda Lejeune (the Netherlands) and of Mrs. Louise van Greunen (Switzerland) we should clearly differentiate between O and R.

What is intended is clear: „No result can be counted twice!“

In the past, we had a problem several times when shooters who shot Comminazzo O wanted their result to be counted in Egg (only O) **and** in Wogdon (O and/or R).

The same problem exists in Lamarmora O where somebody might insist on counting his result twice; i.e. in Koeniggraetz (Lamarmora O) **and** in Enfiled (Lamarmora O and/or R).

And again, the same problem exists in Tanegashima O for team event Nobunaga (Tanegashima O) **and** Nagashino (Tanegashima O and/or R).

To most of the shooters it is absolutely clear that one result can only be counted once!

However, due to the repeatedly occurring discussions, we should find a proper wording and integrate this in our rules.

Proposal:

Under paragraph 4.6 scores, we should make an extension, e.g. „4.6.m“, clearly stating:

An individual score, shot with a firearm which would allow to be counted in two separate team events, can only be counted ONCE. That means that the shooter or the team captain must clearly indicate on the forms in which category the result shall count. No result can be counted in two different team events.

Alternatively, the following, shorter proposal was made by Nick Harvey:

‘A firearm may only be entered in one team competition’.
